

Can we really call health care in the USA a “system”? This course will trace and analyze the development of health care in the United States from the end of the Civil War to the 2000’s. Emphasis is placed on the sociologic, economic, political and philosophic forces that shaped health care organization, structure and financing. We examine how and why we are different from virtually everyone else in the world when it comes to health care and with what results. Finally, in the context of what we have learned from the past, we will examine what challenges we face as the political season unfolds and ideas like “health care reform” and “is health care a right?” are debated.
