Turkish Jews: Jewish legacy in Anatolia and today's Turkey



The history of the Jews in Anatolia started 2400 years ago with the arrival of Romaniot, Mizrahim and Karaites followed later by Ashkenazim and Sephardic Jews. We will examine ancient synagogues, Jewish settlements and cemeteries belonging to different eras and traditions, as well as important events of WWI and WWII. Sephardic cuisine, music, Judeo-Spanish language, and ethnographic and liturgical objects from the museum collection will be explained. Finally we will explore today's vibrant Jewish life in Turkey.

The tour will be led by Nisya Isman Allovi, curator at The Quincentennial Foundation Museum of Turkish Jews and a graduate of the Istanbul Bilgi University, International Relations Department, who will join us live from Istanbul.
